All applicants should complete the application and return it together with the parent and student and student letters along with a description of desired classes to Charleston Community Sailing Inc. (CCSI). There are a limited amount of scholarship funds are available and to award a scholarship, we require the following:

- 1. Parent Letter/Financial Need:** Scholarships are provided based upon demonstrated financial need. As part of the application, parents/guardians must provide a letter stating the reasons the student should receive a scholarship for the program(s) of their choice including the reasons for financial need. *All information will be kept strictly confidential.*
- 2. Student Intent Letter:** As part of the application, the student applicant also must provide a letter explaining his/her particular interest in the programs and why the student would like to take part in the programs.
- 3. Student Highlights Letter:** If your student receives a scholarship, CCSI asks for the student, at the end of the session, to provide a letter describing the student's favorite parts of the program and what they learned. These letters make it possible to provide scholarships in the future.
- 4. Family Contribution:** We ask that all scholarship recipient families contribute at least 5% of the program value or commit to volunteering at CCSI to support our programs.
