1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*;
- 1.2. By the 2016 SAYRA Junior Championship Series Notice of Race;
- 1.3. Appendix T as noted in the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all one-design junior classes with 3 or more boats registered.
- 2.2. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the Entry Form attached to this document. Entry forms will also be available at registration.
- 2.3. All sailors must be under the age of 21
- 2.4. registration can be done online

3. FEES

- Single-handed \$30
- Double-handed \$45

4. SCHEDULE

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions will be available online and at the skippers meeting.

6. RACE AREA: There will be two race courses; all races will be sailed in Charleston Harbor.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2. An unlimited number of races are planned. If six or more races are completed, each boat will have one score excluded. This changes Rule A2.
- 7.3. One race will constitute a series for the regatta.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1. Sections of Appendix T will be in effect; specific rules of Appendix T that will be used in this regatta will be elaborated in the sailing instructions.

9. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded per class as follows:

- 1st place awarded for 3 boats;
- 1st & 2nd for 4-6 boats;
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd for 7-9 boats;
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th for 10 or more boats.
- An overall trophy will be awarded the Optimist class, along with a trophy for each of the Optimist levels.
- The Community Cup will be awarded to the champion of the most competitive class in the regatta as voted on by the community cup board

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Charleston Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
