1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*;
- 1.2 Appendix T as noted in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design junior classes with three or more boats registered.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the Entry Form attached to this document. Entry forms will also be available at registration.
- 2.3 All sailors must be under the age of 21

6 RACE AREA

There will be two race courses; all races will be sailing in Charleston Harbor. Course diagrams will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 An unlimited number of races are planned. If six or more races are completed, each boat will have their non-exempt worst score excluded. This changes Rule A2.
- 7.3 One race will constitute a series for the regatta.

8.1 Sections of Appendix T will be in effect; specific rules of Appendix T that will be used in this regatta are noted in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PRIZES

- 1st place awarded for 3 boats;
- 1st & 2nd for 4-6 boats;
- 1st, 2nd, & 3rd for 7-9 boats;
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th for 10 or more boats.
- The Community Cup will be awarded to the champion of the most competitive class as voted by the Community Cup Board.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Charleston Yacht Club and Charleston Community Sailing will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
